Eden Restored

22 Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, as clear as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb 2 down the middle of the great street of the city. On each side of the river stood the tree of life, bearing twelve crops of fruit. yielding its fruit every month. And the leaves of the tree are for the healing of the nations. ³ No longer will there be any curse. The throne of God and of the Lamb will be in the city, and his servants will serve him. 4 They will see his face, and his name will be on their foreheads. 5 There will be no more night. They will not need the light of a lamp or the light of the sun, for the Lord God will give them light. And they will reign for ever and ever.

Epilogue: Invitation and Warning

Reflection

As we come to the end of Revelation, and the end of the Bible, we see John's vision of a hope that flows like a river, and a tree that will bring healing to the nations. Note how the tree roots actually straddle both banks of the river that flows from 'God and the Lamb'. This can signify Jew and Gentile, or any warring nations. Imagine how this healing tree could stand between Ukraine or Russia, or a country where there is civil unrest.

There are many fruits on the tree, and a variety of them too, which brings to mind Galatians 5:22 "But the fruit of the spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control".

Added to the water of life that flows out to all people and the fruits of the tree on offer at all times and seasons, there are edible leaves for healing. Ezekiel 47:12 says "fruit trees of all kinds will grow on the banks of the river. Their leaves will not wither, nor their fruit fail".

John sees a time when people will cease to war, where all will be fed, and all will be healed, because the fruits on offer mean we will love and take care of each other.

Do you feel that is a possibility, that there will a time of peace on earth? It can be difficult to have that hope, especially when watching the news on TV. Yet, in v 6, the angel said, "These words are trustworthy and true. The Lord, the God who inspires the prophets, sent his angel to show his servants the things that must soon take place".

The God who inspired the prophets with words of warning and wisdom, is the same God who sent his son Jesus to teach and guide us, and he is the same God who sends us a message of hope today, that his purposes – his plans, will be brought to fruition. Through the fruits of the Spirit, we can be part of that purpose. It's not too difficult to be kind, or gentle; patience may need work, as can self-control, but if we keep faithful than we can sow seeds of love, joy and peace.

In v12 we hear Jesus speak "Behold, I am coming soon. My reward is with me and I will give to everyone according to what he has done". Jesus offers a reward to those who follow him. The phrase "blessed are those who wash robes, refers to the people who strive daily to live a sin-free life and to be faithful to God. Those who do that "have the right to the tree of life and may go through the gates into the city". That city can be envisaged as a return to the Garden of Eden. In Genesis 3: 22-24, you can read how Adam and Eve were barred from the Garden. In Revelation we read how, through Christ, we can enter and we can eat from the tree of life when we acknowledge He died for us, as a sacrifice for our sins.

The Holy Spirit and the bride (meaning the church) in v17, tell us to come. It is an invitation to all the world to come to Jesus and receive the salvation on offer through him. We are freely offered this invitation to drink the water of life and eat from the tree of life. Are you ready to accept the invitation?
